This critical edition of *Eugenia* makes a forgotten utopian/dystopian novel accessible to those addressing issues of gender, medicine, technology and socio-political order in the early 19th century. This exquisite translation of the novel is enriched by remarkable critical texts with a deep interdisciplinary approach.
